Junior	-	On-The-Spot Painting, Declamation, and Vocal Duet
Senior	-	Folk Dance and Essay Writing
Cadet	-	Guitar Solo and Spoken Poetry

PROVINCIAL GIRL SCOUTS GOT TALENT 2024
Fiscal Year July 2024 - June 2025
Theme: "Girls of Today for the Women of Tomorrow"

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Contestants to the Provincial Girl Scouts Got Talent (PGSGT) must be the declared First Prize Winners in their respective categories at the Area Level Girl Scouts Got Talent to be eligible for participation.
2. Contestants must not have previously won First Prize in the same category/level in any prior PGSGT events.
3. Contestants must be registered Girl Scouts who will compete in only one category corresponding to their age level.
4. Contestants must wear the official Girl Scout Dress Uniform, complete with scarf, pins, and cap, for all categories. However, an exception applies to the Folk Dance category, where participants must wear traditional or required attire specific to the dance.
5. District Field Advisers (DFAs) of host districts must submit the following documents to the Council after the Area Level competition:
 - Copy of the Area Level Results, including contest category, winner's details, troop information, and registration date.
 - Photocopy of the Troop Registration Form and Official Receipt for first-place winners
6. Contestants and District Field Advisers must arrive at the venue prior to the program start time. This allows for registration and the drawing of lots to determine the order of performance. Please refer to Council Circular No. 21, S.2024 for the specific time schedule.
7. Contestants must attend the Opening Program of the competition at the venue.
8. Contestants are expected to strictly adhere to both the General Guidelines and Contest-Specific Guidelines.
9. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and non-appealable.
