DESIGNATION OF BOHOL ISLAND GLOBAL GEOPARK SCHOOL COORDINATOR

1. In line with the mission of fostering environmental awareness, sustainable development, and cultural preservation, the Bohol Island Global Geopark initiative aims to promote educational programs that emphasize geosciences, biodiversity, and heritage conservation among students. As part of this mission, we are requesting the selected secondary school within the identified geological sites in the province to designate a **Bohol Island Global Geopark School Coordinator** to oversee and lead the Geopark Club in schools across the division. This position is critical in ensuring that students engage in meaningful activities that deepen their appreciation for Bohol's unique ecological and cultural landscapes while nurturing a global perspective.
2. The designated coordinator should meet the following qualifications:
 - **Position Requirement:** Must be either a Araling Panlipunan or Science teacher with a background or strong interest in environmental studies and conservation.
 - **Leadership Qualities:** Demonstrates positive leadership qualities with the ability to inspire and guide students in club activities, and to work collaboratively with other faculty and stakeholders.
 - **Commitment to Environmental Education:** Shows a strong commitment to promoting environmental education and sustainable development initiatives aligned with the goals of the Bohol Island Global Geopark.
3. The duties and responsibilities of a Bohol Island Global Geopark School Coordinator are to:
 - lead the Geopark Club activities, focusing on geosciences, biodiversity, cultural heritage, and conservation initiatives.
 - develop and implement programs that align with the Global Geopark's objectives, such as field visits, environmental campaigns, and educational workshops.



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- collaborate with other teachers, local government units, and non-governmental organizations to enhance the learning experiences related to Bohol's ecological and cultural heritage.
 - encourage students' active participation in projects and events organized under the Geopark initiative, promoting responsible stewardship of natural resources.
