The Girl Scouts of the Philippines, Visayas Region, will conduct its **Regional Junior, Senior and Cadet Camp** on **March 10-14, 2025**, at Camp Lily I. Gamo, Ajong Sibulan, Negros Oriental. The camp will carry the theme "EmpowHERment Through Adventure: Leading with Confidence, Living with Purpose".
