We would like to inform your esteemed organization that the Provincial Government of Bohol (PGBh) through the Office of the Provincial Agriculturist (OPA) has been conducting Fruit-Bearing Trees and Bamboo seedlings production for Tree Growing activities in different parts of Bohol.

This, as the Provincial Government of Bohol (PGBh) abides by Section 2 of RA 10176 which provides that, "it shall be the policy of the State to protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;" which recognizes the vital role and importance of trees in ecological stability.

Anent to this, we are encouraging Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), Civic Organizations, Schools, Churches, Hotels, Resorts and Companies to conduct Tree Growing activities in their respective localities for their Civic Projects and/or Corporate Social Responsibility Projects.

The OPA, through its established plant nurseries in Del Carmen Sur, Balilihan; Macaas, Tubigon; and Gabi, Ubay has been producing seedlings of Fruit-Bearing Trees and Bamboos to be used in these activities.

The available seedlings, such as, Mango, Chestnut, Starfruit, Avocado, Coffee, Pomelo, Santol, Guava, Atis, Tambis, Jackfruit, Cacao, Lemon, Guyabano, Rambutan, Lomboy, Marang, Mulberry, Lemonsito, Lime, Magicfruit, Mangosteen, Lanzones, Durian, Tamarind, Chicos and Tambis, can be given for the purpose of dispersal through first come - first served basis under Provincial Ordinance No. 2020-004.
