**ADMINISTRATION OF THE NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT TEST FOR GRADE 6 FOR
SCHOOL YEAR 2024-2025**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) will administer the **National Achievement Test for Grade 6 (NATG6)** for School Year (SY) 2024-2025, pursuant to DepEd Order (DO) No. 55, s. 2016, titled "*Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Program*" on **March 31, 2025** to Public and Private Elementary Schools operating with permit.
2. The conduct of the test is pursuant to DO 009, s. 2024, titled "*Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2024-2025*".
3. In accordance with DO 27, s. 2022, titled "*Conduct of Rapid Assessment in School Year 2021-2022 for Learning Recovery as well as in Preparation for the 2024 Baseline System Assessment*", **the current Grade 6 learners of the present SY will be taking the test.**
4. The NATG6 will be administered on a paper-based modality to all public elementary schools, and private schools operating with permit.
5. The **NATG6** is an exit assessment that is designed to determine if Grade 6 learners are meeting the learning standards in the Elementary curriculum. The test design measures **five** learning areas (*English, Mathematics, Science, Filipino, and Araling Panlipunan*) in a multiple-choice format.
6. The Language of Testing for the following learning areas are as follows:

Language of Testing	Learning Areas
English	English, Science, and Mathematics
Filipino	Filipino and Araling Panlipunan



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7. A virtual orientation for Public School District Supervisors (PSDSs), Elementary School Heads (SHs), and School Testing Coordinators (STCs) from both public and private schools regarding test administration will be held on March 26, 2025. The meeting link will be shared in the PSDSs' group chat.
8. Learners with Disabilities (LWDs) may also be assessed provided that the test accommodations stipulated in **Section 9 of DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2016** are met.
9. Health and safety protocols must be followed in all activities related to the national test administration.
11. The delivery of test materials is scheduled for March 29-30, 2025, while the retrieval is set for April 1, 2025. Teachers and School Heads involved in the retrieval process are entitled to a one-day (1) service credit or compensatory time off (CTO).
12. In relation to this, Division personnel and PSDSs shall monitor on the conduct of the assessment programs to ensure smooth conduct of the said activities. Travel and other incidental expenses incurred by the monitoring team shall be charged against Division/School MOOE, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
