**QUALIFIED CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT (CI) PROGRAM PROJECTS
FOR ONSITE VALIDATION**

1. This office, through the Schools Governance Operations Division and Curriculum Implementation Division, announces the **nine (9) most qualified CI projects** per congressional district for **Onsite Validation on March 24- 28, 2025**.
2. The documents review conducted last **March 21-22, 2025**, by the CI Division Technical Working Group, came up with three qualified CI Projects for each congressional district. The nine (9) CI projects were chosen from among the submitted CI portfolios, SIP/AIP, MOVS and ACRs of the selected projects from the 58 districts through symposium or monitoring and evaluation conducted per issued timeline.
3. Selected schools may opt to present their documents in a booth or whichever way they thought is best applicable to convey the authenticity and validity of their projects. Still be guided of the criteria used during the symposium except letter G.
4. Assigned Division TWGs will visit the qualified schools on any of the scheduled dates. Schools and validators shall closely coordinate as to the specific date and scheme the CI teams employ to maximize time, effort, and achievement of objectives during the validation. **Public Schools District Supervisors of qualified schools are required to join the validation team.**
5. Results from the onsite validation will determine the finality of the project's qualification for declaration of the top three most outstanding CI projects through another memorandum. **The chosen most outstanding division CI project will represent the division during the annual PASIDUNGOG, the Regional Search for Outstanding Program Implementer (OPI).**
6. The District CI Team led by the PSDS shall conduct coaching and mentoring to the winning CI project team for the validation and the regional search.

7. The following documents are attached for the guidance of everyone concerned, to wit:
 - List of qualified CI projects per congressional district.
 - Assignment of Division CI coaches during the onsite validation
 - Criteria
8. Relevant expenses such as travel, materials, and other incidentals incurred during onsite validation of the top 3 projects per congressional district shall be charged against school/division MOOE, SEF and other local funds subject to the usual COA auditing rules and guidelines.
9. This Memorandum also serves as a **Travel Order**.
10. For the guidance and compliance of all concerned.
