CONDUCT OF 2025 BRIGADA ESKWELA PROGRAM

1. To prepare the schools for the opening of School Year 2025-2026, this Office shall conduct the 2025 Brigada Eskwela Program in all public schools in this division on June 9-13, 2025.
2. The Brigada Eskwela is a five-day activity that upholds the spirit of bayanihan, encouraging community collaboration to prepare schools for the upcoming school year. With literacy as a key priority of the Department, this year's theme, **Brigada Eskwela: Sama-sama Para sa Bayang Bumabasa**, highlights a nationwide effort and volunteerism on literacy development. The program also serves various purposes like the usual preparing and improving the school facilities and environment, supporting the physical and mental well-being of learners, addressing the needs of engaging parents and stakeholders, and ensuring the accuracy of educational data through a nationwide inventory validation.
3. The Regional Brigada Eskwela Kick-off Program shall be held on **June 9, 2025**, at Carmen 2 Central Elementary School of this division, while the schools will organize their respective kick-off activities simultaneously on **June 10, 2025**.
4. In addition, all District Adopt-A-School Program Coordinators are enjoined to attend the orientation on the 2025 Brigada Eskwela Program on May 20, 2025, at SDO Conference Hall which will start at 1:00 in the afternoon.



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5. Expenses relative to the above activity shall be chargeable against the PSF-BPLP Funds, School/Division MOOE and Local Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
