1. This is to announce the participation of SDO Bohol to the 24th Philippine Robotics Olympiad with the theme: "The Future of Robots" on **July 21-23, 2025, at Music Hall, SM Mall of Asia Complex, Jose W. Diokno Boulevard, SM Central Business Park, Bay City, Pasay, Metro Manila.**
2. Attached is **Regional Memorandum 0687, s. 2025**, which specifies the objectives of the event and the list of participants.
3. The teams of Elementary, Junior, and Senior High School Students from **Japer Memorial High School -Sagbayan, Ubay National Science High School- Ubay 1, San Jose National High School of Talibon 2, Sta. Catalina Elementary School – Sagbayan and Tubigon West Central High School – Tubigon West** are joining the event. These schools were hailed as champions in the different contested categories during the **2025th BOHOL ROBOTICS EXPO and OLYMPIAD** held last April 2025.
4. This is another opportunity for the Boholano learners and coaches to prove their excellence in analytical thinking through robotics that promotes Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics.
5. It is notable to mention that Japer MHS invaded Italy as champion in the Robomission JHS category and grabbed the Breakthrough award during the 2024th FLL World Championship in Houston, Texas, USA, among 160 teams. Tubigon West Central High School finished in 3rd place during the 2024th National Robotics Competition.
6. In this regard, this office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division, also encourages other schools to consider this opportunity as a platform for learners to engage in real-world robotics applications that promote collaboration, critical and creative thinking skills that ultimately transform



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their innate faculties to be productive individuals as scientists, engineers, inventors, mathematicians, and data analysts in the future workplace.

7. Travel, meals, accommodation, and other incidental expenses incurred relative to the participation in this national competition shall be chargeable to School/Division MOOE, SEF, and other local funds, subject to the usual COA rules and guidelines.
8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
