In line with the continuing efforts to promote the Bohol Island Geopark, we are pleased to announce the **Geopark/4Geon Club Advisers' Meeting and Action Planning Workshop** to be held on **July 25, 2025**. This event aims to strengthen school-based Geo/4Geon Clubs and align their activities with the Geopark's thematic pillars: education, conservation, and sustainable development..
2. To ensure the success of Geo Club initiatives, this activity has been organized to provide a collaborative platform for teachers. The objectives of this activity include aligning school-based activities with the Geopark's thematic pillars—education, conservation, and sustainable development. Additionally, the event will focus on developing a year-round plan of activities and establishing a network of support and coordination among Geo Club Advisers across schools in the province.
