The Bohol Girl Scout Council invites schools and districts to conduct the Josefa Llanes Escoda (JLE) School/District Camp, scheduled for weekends (Saturdays and Sundays) or holidays from September to November 2025, with the theme "Once A Girl Scout, Always A Girl Scout.". The Girl Scout camp aims to foster citizenship, character development, and community engagement among young girls, aligning with the core objectives of Girl Scouting.

Camping Objectives:

1. To stimulate real enjoyment and appreciation out-of-doors through progressive camping experiences.
2. To develop resourcefulness, initiative and self-reliance.
3. To provide new and interesting experience with the opportunity for acquiring new skills.
4. To develop the individual's physical and mental well-being.
5. To help a girl in her ability to be an accepted and adjusted member of a group.
6. To foster international friendship.

Guidelines

- All participating girls and adult leaders must be registered Girl Scouts.
- Participants must wear the prescribed Girl Scout uniform throughout the activity.
- Strict adherence to camping guidelines and safety protocols must be observed.
- Girls must submit a signed Parent's Consent Form prior to participation

Suggested and Possible Activities

The activities listed below are suggested for the camp. However, girls and troop leaders are encouraged to creatively plan and implement their own exciting and engaging activities that align with the camp's objectives.

Handcrafts, Arts, Nature Lore, Hikes, Song and Dance, Sports, Games (Scout Games, Wide Games, Team Games, Singing Games), Community Service, Tree/Mangrove Planting, Non-Utensil Cooking, Anti-Dengue Campaign, Membership Campaign, and Mutya ng Girl Scout (Junior, Senior or Cadet).

Activities under the GSP Eight-Point Challenge Program; activities of the programs on Free Being Me (FBM), Action on Body Confidence (ABC), Girl Powered Nutrition (GPN), Stop the Violence (STV); and Sustainable Development Goals (SDG).

Transportation/Food Expense

The transportation and food expenses of campers during District Camp may be charged to the Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), Special Education Fund (SEF), or any other available source of funds, subject to the approval of DepEd Bohol and DepEd Tagbilaran City Divisions, and in accordance with the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Service Credit/Compensatory Overtime Credit

The Adult Leaders/Troop and Co-Leaders shall be entitled to either Service Credit or Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) whichever is applicable, in accordance with DepEd Guidelines.
