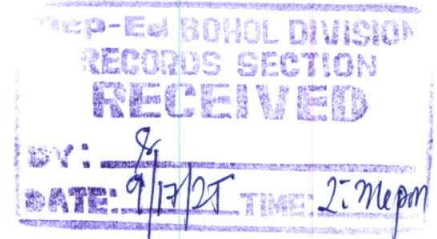

MUTYA NG GIRL SCOUT 2025

A. GUIDELINES

1. The project is open to currently registered Girl Scouts of the following age levels:
Junior (Grade 4-6) Senior (Grade 7-10) Cadet (Grade 11-12, College)
2. Each district is encouraged to select and enter one qualified candidate.
3. Districts conducting a District Mutya ng Girl Scout must submit their winning candidate for consideration at the Council/Provincial Level.
4. Non-participating districts must contribute Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) in support of the project.
5. Voting is based on a monetary system wherein one Philippines Peso (P1.00) equals one vote. Only Philippine currency in cash is accepted, with a minimum denomination of One Peso (P1.00).
6. The Council will provide envelopes bearing serial numbers for voting, subject to a minimum purchase of 100 pieces by districts.
7. A registration fee of Five Hundred (P500.00) shall be collected from each candidate, serving as initial votes.
8. Candidates must submit the following to the Council on or before October 30, 2025.
 - Two (2) colored 2x2 photos with a white background, wearing the GSP Dress Uniform
 - A completed personal data sheet
9. Canvassing of votes will take place on two scheduled dates (Refer to the Timetable).
10. Following the Final Canvassing, the candidate with the highest number of votes shall be proclaimed the winner.
11. Proceeds (excluding the registration fee) will be shared according to the following tiered system:
 - 50% share: For proceeds amounting to P 30,000.00 and above
 - 10% share: For proceeds ranging from P 5,001.00 to P 29,999.00
