Bohol Division Poster Making Contest in Celebration of World Food Day

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 0840, s. 2025, and in line with the celebration of the World Food Day 2025 spearheaded by the Department of Agriculture (DA), the Department of Education – Division of Bohol announces the conduct of the World Food Day 2025: On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest with the theme: “Hand in Hand for Better Foods and Brighter Future.”
2. This activity is open to all public elementary schools in the Division of Bohol, specifically for Grades V–VI learners. There should be one (1) entry per district.
3. Bohol Division Guidelines for Participation:
 - a. 1-inch border on all sides must be observed; the theme should be written outside the border and must not be included in the artwork itself.
 - b. At the back of the illustration board, the following must be clearly written:
 - Name of Contestant, Grade Level, Name of School and District
 - Name of Coach, School and PSDS and their Contact Number
 - c. Contestants not following the instructions will be automatically disqualified.

Visual Impact	The poster is eye-catching, well-organized, and leaves a strong impression.	25%
Relevance to Theme	The message of the poster clearly reflects the World Food Day theme.	25%

2025 WORLD FOOD DAY ON-THE-SPOT POSTER MAKING CONTEST

The Department of Agriculture (DA), in partnership with the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, will conduct the 2025 World Food Day (WFD) celebration.

The activity aims to instill in young minds the importance of WFD and its advocacy. This annual event will feature, as one of its key highlights, the nationwide On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest, which will take place on the following dates at the specified venues:

Activity	Dates and Venues
Regional Level Contest	August–September 2025 The activity will be facilitated by the DA-Agriculture and Fisheries Information Division and the DA-Regional Offices through their respective Regional Agriculture and Fisheries Information Sections.
National Level Competition	October 15, 2025 Metro Manila
Culminating Activity	October 15, 2025 Quezon City

Learners in Grades V and VI enrolled in public and DepEd-accredited private elementary schools nationwide are encouraged to participate in this event. However, previous national winners are not eligible to join the competition.

Participation of learners and teachers from public and private schools shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper instructional time in compliance with the provisions of DepEd Order (DO) No. 012, s. 2025, titled Multi-Year Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities and DO 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and the policy on off-campus activities stated in DO 66, s. 2017.

This is also subject to the no-collection policy as stated in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546 also known as An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges and Universities (Ganzon Law), issued in DO 19, s. 2008, and reiterated in DepEd Memorandum No. 041, s. 2024.

Greetings!

Once again, the Philippines together with the other countries worldwide will celebrate the World Food Day on October 16, 2025 with the theme **"Hand in hand for better foods and better future"**.

Anent to this celebration, the Department of Agriculture (DA) and the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations, in partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd) will conduct an On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest both in the regional and national level on September 25, 2025 and October 15, 2025, respectively.

The contest is open to all Grades V to VI pupils enrolled in any public and DepEd accredited private elementary schools. Previous national winners are not eligible to join the competition.

For the regional on-the spot poster making contest, DepEd divisions (city and province) from Bohol and Cebu may send a maximum of three contestants, respectively, to participate in the regional level competition on September 25, 2025 at Bayfront Hotel North Reclamation, Cebu City which will start at 8:30AM. For those Divisions beyond the 50KM radius, please inquire from the DA7 RAFIS secretariat (refer to the persons mentioned) for details.

We will be providing the necessary materials needed for the contest such as illustration board (size 20"x30"), craypass (oil pastel), pentel pen, pencil, ruler, among others. The contest guidelines are the following: 1) The poster should be an original creation of the contestant depicting the given theme contest; 2) The theme should be written outside the illustration board's border (1-inch border on all sides) and not be included in the artwork itself; and 3) Contestants not following the instructions will be automatically disqualified. Attached is the contest mechanics for reference and guidance.

The regional winner will compete at the national level contest (face-to-face) on October 15, 2025 in Manila. Plane fare and accommodation will be shouldered by the DA regional and national offices, respectively.
