1. Another batch of training for our School Paper Advisers and the Campus Journalists as preparation for the upcoming 2025 Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC). The Bohol Association of School Paper Advisers (BASPA) Inc. shall conduct an **Upscaling on Campus Journalism for SY 2025-2026 (Batch 2)** on **October 13-14, 2025 @ Reynas The Haven, New Calceta Street, Tagbilaran City.**
2. Included in the training are the topics on Radio Broadcasting and TV Broadcasting, a group category in our DSPC.
3. The first 500 participants for the CJs and 120 for the SPAs are the priority participants to this activity due to the availability of our venue. Interested SPAs and CJs must **individually register via online.**

4. This training is open to School Paper Advisers and Campus Journalists from the public and private elementary and secondary schools in this division.
5. BASPA Inc. Officers and staff are required to attend to this training as PMT and be at the venue on day zero October 12, 2025 (Sunday) for the preparation of the training kit and other materials needed for the training.
6. Participants are encouraged to pay in advance and be at the venue on time. The First meal is **breakfast** on October 13 and the last meal is **pm snack** on October 14.
7. A registration fee of **Two Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P2,800.00)** shall be collected from each participant to defray for the meals, snacks, & venue (**P2,500.00**) and the honorarium of speakers & training materials (**P300.00**). The registration, traveling and other incidental expenses relative to this activity are chargeable against SP Funds, school MOOE, SEF and other



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school funds subject to the usual COA rules and regulations. For private schools, they may use any funds subject to its availability and Principal's approval.
