Humanitarian greetings!

In the spirit of our continued partnership between the Department of Education (DepEd) and the Philippine Red Cross (PRC) – Bohol Chapter, we respectfully remind all schools to remit their **School Aid contributions for School Year (SY) 2024–2025 (if pending)** and the current **SY 2025–2026**.

This membership program is **backed by Republic Act No. 10072 (Philippine Red Cross Act of 2009)** and aligned with **DepEd Order No. 013, s. 2022 (Omnibus Guidelines)**. We will continue to accept the ₱10.00 contribution from previous school years while we **slowly transition** to fully follow the Omnibus guidelines from DepEd. Considering both the **previous contributions in Bohol** and the **updated national policy**, schools may choose from the following contribution options:

Contribution Options

Option	Amount (per learner)	Coverage / Benefits
A. School Aid (previous contributions)	₱10.00	Direct support to PRC humanitarian services (accepted for previous school years until full transition).
B. Omnibus Guideline	₱50.00	Official PRC contribution package under DepEd Order 013, s. 2022.
C. Comprehensive Support Package	₱70.00	Combination of ₱60.00 (MAAB accidental coverage) + ₱10.00 School Aid , ensuring both membership protection and humanitarian service support.

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We also encourage **teachers and personnel** to avail of the **Safe Card (₱1,200)** or **PRC Silver Membership (₱300)**, which provides protection and reinforces their commitment to humanitarian service.

These contributions, guided by **RA 10072**, directly strengthen Red Cross programs in Bohol—from disaster response and first aid training, to blood services and volunteer development. Most importantly, enrolling students in the **₱70.00 Comprehensive Support Package** ensures **accidental coverage protection** for them and their families while also supporting humanitarian initiatives.

To further encourage participation, the PRC-Bohol Chapter will provide **incentives and certificates of appreciation** to schools that remit their contributions.

Attached is the updated list of schools **with remitted and not-yet-remitted** status for SY 2023–2024 and SY 2024–2025. If your school is listed as **not yet remitted** but has already sent its contribution, kindly contact us so we can **update our records accordingly**.

We also request that remittances be made **before school clearance** so we may report to the **PRC Bohol Board of Directors** and during **Division meetings**.
