Food, accommodation, and other incidental expenses incurred by the members of the program management team, TWG, and participants shall be charged to division HRTD funds while travelling, and other related expenses shall be charged to division MOOE and school MOOE for school heads and teacher participants, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
