I. Title of the Project

(A Celebration of Values Education Month)

II. Rationale

Week 2	Poster-Making & Essay-Writing Contests	Focus on the theme; winners announced during closing
Week 2	Values Talk Series	Guest speakers share experiences related to honesty, compassion, etc.
Week 3	Acts of Kindness Challenge	Students track daily acts of kindness for recognition
Week 3	Role-Playing / Skit Competition	Short skits showcasing value-based decision making

Date	Activity	Description
Week 4	Outreach or Service Project	e.g., donation drive, community clean-up, visit to elderly home
Final Day	Recognition & Culminating Program	Performances, awarding of winners, and reflection sharing
