1. This communication is in reference to the Regional Memorandum No. 1028 s. 2025 entitled as the "**Conduct of School- Based Immunization Program**". The SBI program supposedly runs for two (2) months from October to November 2025. However, due to the recent unfortunate calamities experienced by the region, most of the classes were suspended or in alternative delivery mode thus SBI cannot be conducted to the target schools.
2. In line with this, the **DepEd Regional Office VII** supports the request of the **Department of Health (DOH)** to continue the SBI Program implementation to all DepEd schools within the jurisdiction of the 12 Schools Division Offices (SDOs) **until December 2025**. This will ensure more time for our learners to be able to receive the protection they need from Vaccine Preventable Diseases (VPDs).
3. The SDOs, through their SBI Focal Persons, are further instructed to closely coordinate with their local government unit (LGU) counterparts on the agreed schedule of school visits to avoid disruption of classes.
4. Attached herewith is the communication letter from DOH-CHD VII.
5. Immediate dissemination and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

The School-based Immunization (SBI) “Bakuna Eskwela” 2025, implemented by the Department of Health (DOH) in collaboration with the Department of Education (DepEd) from October to November (*DOH Department Memorandum No. 2025-0318*) aims to protect school-aged children against vaccine-preventable diseases (VPDs) such as measles, rubella, tetanus diphtheria, and human papillomavirus.

With the recent 6.9 magnitude earthquake and tropical storm “Tino” which has severely affected Central Visayas and severely damaged infrastructures including houses and schools, classes were suspended to ensure safety of the community including students and learners. Thus, we humbly request for the extension of the SBI until December 2025, to ensure safety of students and to prevent the spread of VPDs.
