1. The Alternative Learning System (ALS) plays a vital role in ensuring inclusive and equitable access to quality education for out-of-school youth and adults. In line with the Department of Education's thrust to strengthen evidence-based planning, monitoring, and accountability, this office shall conduct the **ALS Calendar Year (CY) 2026 Program Implementation Review and Target Setting on January 8-9, 2026 at the Panda Tea Garden**. This activity aims to assess the implementation status, accomplishments, challenges, and best practices of ALS programs for the previous cycle and to collaboratively set realistic, data-driven targets for CY 2026 aligned with national and division priorities.
2. The objectives of this activity:
  - Review and evaluate the implementation of ALS programs, projects, and activities based on CY 2025 performance and existing data;
  - Identify gaps, challenges, and priority areas in ALS delivery, including access, participation, completion, and learner performance;
  - Highlight best practices and innovative strategies in ALS implementation at the district and school levels;
  - Align ALS plans and targets with DepEd policies, the Basic Education Development Plan (BEDP), and division strategic directions;
  - Set clear, measurable, and achievable ALS targets for Calendar Year 2026 to guide program implementation, monitoring, and support mechanisms; and
