2026 REGIONAL FESTIVAL OF TALENTS (RFOT)

1. In line with the goal of delivering quality, relevant, inclusive, and responsive basic education, the Department of Education (DepEd) Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will conduct the 2026 Regional Festival of Talents (RFOT) with the theme, **“Embracing Change, Redefining Excellence”** to be hosted by the Schools Division Office (SDO) of Cebu Province in collaboration with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Dalaguete, Cebu on March 16-20, 2026 (inclusive of travel time).

2. The activity aims to:

- a. embrace change in gauging learners’ holistic development by showcasing inclusive, authentic, and interdisciplinary products and performances on a regional platform, and;
- b. highlight the significance of redefining academic excellence beyond traditional approaches by promoting the integration of knowledge across disciplines and encouraging learners to be creative, innovative, and collaborative in demonstrating their multiple intelligences and 21st century skills to successfully thrive in a dynamic, interconnected, and future-ready world.

3. Participants to this activity are the Schools Division Superintendents, Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, CLMD/CID Chief Education Supervisors, Regional/Division FOT focal persons, Technical Working Group (TWG), learner-participants, teacher-coaches, and working committees.

4. The Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are enjoined to ensure the following:

- meals of their delegates for the entire duration of the contest;
- transportation to and from billeting quarters to contest venues;
- portable mats, beddings, pillows and blankets; and
- other supplies and materials necessary for the conduct of the different events

6. To ensure the safety, health and well-being of all RFOT delegates, strict observance of minimum health protocols shall be implemented within all activity premises.

7. There shall only be one (1) Travel Order per participant duly approved by the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS). However, in case of replacements of participants, there shall be an official endorsement from the authorized signatory.

8. Meals, transportation, materials, and other incidental expenses incurred by learner-participants, teacher-coaches, division focal persons, and other official delegates shall be charged to Division/School MOOE, local funds and other eligible fund sources, while travelling and other incidental expenses of the regional participants shall be charged to Regional Funds, all are subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
