1. This is to announce the participation of SDO Bohol in the **25<sup>th</sup> Philippine Robotics Olympiad on June 22–25, 2026**, at the **Music Hall, SM Mall of Asia, Seaside Boulevard, Pasay City**, to be represented by the winners during the **2nd Bohol Robotics Expo and Olympiad 2026**, held last **May 4–6, 2026**, at the **Bohol Quality Mall Atrium**.
2. Attached are the official lists of winners in the different contest categories, the **DepEd Advisory No.069, s. 2026 issued on March 27, 2026**, and **Regional Memorandum No.0477, s. 2026 issued on May 28, 2026**. **First-place winners** shall receive financial support from the Provincial Government, as they represent the division and the province in the **Philippine Robotics Olympiad**. Other teams are permitted to participate to gain exposure to a national competition and benefit from the learning experience.
3. School Heads shall ensure that the schedules of teacher-coaches accompanying the teams are properly arranged, and that their classes are effectively managed, so as not to disrupt or compromise instructional delivery.
4. Expenses for travel, food, and accommodation of the robotics teams' first-place winners shall be charged to the **School MOOE, Provincial SEF, and other local funds**. In contrast, other participating schools in the BREQ that did not win first place are permitted to join the national competition at their



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own expense, using local SEF, PTA, or other available funds, subject to the usual COA rules and regulations.

5. This memorandum likewise serves as a **TRAVEL ORDER**.
