MONITORING OF THE ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) PROGRAM

1. Attached is **Regional Memorandum No. 162, s. 2026**, titled "**Monitoring of the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Program for School Year 2026–2027 in Select Schools Division Offices**," for the information and guidance of all concerned.
2. Pursuant to the said Regional Memorandum, the Schools Division of Bohol shall facilitate the conduct of the national/regional monitoring in the following Community Learning Centers (CLCs):
 - a. Baclayon District CLC
 - b. Balilihan District CLC
 - c. Pilar Technical-Vocational High School (TVHS) ALS Senior High School
 - d. Other Community Learning Centers (CLCs) as may be recommended by the Division ALS Focal Person.
3. The monitoring team shall assess the implementation of the ALS Program based on the areas and indicators stipulated in the attached Regional Memorandum. All concerned ALS implementers are therefore directed to familiarize themselves with the monitoring tool and ensure compliance with the required standards.
4. The designated Division facilitators for this activity are:
 - **Mr. Neil John C. Jabujab**, Education Program Specialist II – ALS
 - **Ms. Elsa F. Hingpit**, Education Program Specialist II – ALS

They shall coordinate with the National/Regional Monitoring Team, organize the schedule of visits, facilitate the monitoring activities, and provide the necessary technical assistance to the identified CLCs.



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5. All ALS teachers and implementers in the identified CLCs are expected to prepare and make available the following during the monitoring:
 - a. Learners' records and pertinent program documents;
 - b. Required forms and documentary evidence supporting program implementation;
 - c. Identified issues and concerns encountered in program delivery; and
 - d. Promising practices and innovations that demonstrate effective implementation of the ALS Program.
6. During the monitoring, the personnel from the **Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE)** assigned to the activity shall conduct a **Focus Group Discussion (FGD)** with randomly selected ALS learners to validate program implementation and gather relevant feedback from the beneficiaries.
7. Expenses incurred by the Division facilitators, particularly the travel expenses of the assigned Education Program Specialists for Alternative Learning System (EPSAs), shall be charged against available **Special Education Fund (SEF)** and **Schools Division Office (SDO)** funds, subject to the usual government accounting, auditing, and budgeting rules and regulations.
8. This memorandum also serves as a **TRAVEL ORDER**.
9. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

1. In line with DepEd Memorandum DM-OULS-2026-242 dated June 17, 2026 from the Undersecretary for Learning Systems, regarding **Monitoring of the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Program for School Year 2026-2027 in Select Schools Division Offices (SDOs)**, the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) shall conduct three (3) phases of monitoring activities on the following SDOs:

2. The monitoring activities aim to comprehensively monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Alternative Learning System Program to
 - a. collect ALS Key Performance Indicators data;
 - b. identify best practices in ALS programs;
 - c. optimize learning outcomes; and
 - d. inform data-driven policy recommendations for continuous program improvement.
3. The Regional and concerned Division ALS Focal Persons, and Education Program Specialists II (EPSAs) for ALS are part of the Technical Working Group (TWG) and are requested to provide the necessary assistance and coordination to facilitate the smooth conduct of these monitoring activities.
4. Expenses for meals, travel, and other incidental expenses incurred by the TWG shall be charged against the Regional/ Division ALS Program Support Fund (PSF), subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
