1. Attached is Regional Memorandum No. 0584, s. 2026, titled "2026 Nutrition Month Celebration," for the information, guidance, and appropriate action of all concerned.

2. In line with the observance of the 2026 Nutrition Month Celebration every July pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 491, schools are encouraged to actively participate in activities spearheaded by the National Nutrition Council (NNC) with this year's theme:

"Nutrisyong At Kalikasan, Ang Pangalagaan! This year's celebration emphasizes the strong connection between proper nutrition and environmental protection, highlighting the importance of sustainable food systems and climate-resilient practices in ensuring food security and improving the health and well-being of present and future generations."

3. The campaign aims to:

- a. Raise awareness on the importance of proper nutrition in preventing hunger and malnutrition;
- b. Promote the relationship between nutrition, sustainable food systems, and environmental conservation;
- c. Encourage healthy eating, food security, and sustainable food practices, including reducing food waste and supporting local and seasonal foods;
- d. Advocate for inclusive and climate-resilient food systems; and
- e. Strengthen the participation and support of government agencies, local government units, schools, private organizations, and communities in promoting nutrition and environmental sustainability.

4. Schools are encouraged to conduct Nutrition Month activities that are aligned with the objectives of the campaign. The conduct of these activities must not disrupt instructional time and shall comply with DepEd Order No. 09, s. 2026 and other existing DepEd policies.
