This office, through the Schools' Governance Operations Division in partnership with the Curriculum Implementation Division, **CONGRATULATES Montesuerte Elementary School of Carmen III District** for topping the other two candidate CI projects from CD 1 and 2 during the revalidation conducted on July 21, 2026. 2. **Montesuerte Elementary School's Project SCRIPTS has been selected to represent Bohol Division in this year's Regional Pasidungog.** The project stood out for its strong effectiveness and its direct positive impact on learners, earning the full confidence of the validating team.
3. We also commend the other two CI projects of Calape NHS and Busalian ES, which demonstrated excellent innovation and replicability. Each offered systematic solutions to recurring challenges in schools, reflecting the collective commitment of our division to continuous improvement.
4. To ensure wider sharing and learning, all projects will be uploaded to the CI applications section of our website.
5. **This is to reiterate that schools are expected to have already initiated the first stage of their CI projects, as data from various assessments are now available. In this regard, a challenge is posed**



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to both schools and their assigned coaches across the districts: to develop and deliver the most outstanding CI projects in the upcoming CI season, this SY 2026-2027.

6. For coaching sessions that coaches will conduct on their respective assignments, Service Credits and /or Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) shall be granted to the participants for services rendered falling on either a holiday or a weekend in accordance with DepEd Order 23, s. 2003, Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to teachers and CSC-DBM Circular No. 2, s. 2015, Policies and Guidelines on Overtime Services and Overtime Pay for Government Employees, respectively.

7. Relevant expenses such as travel, food, accommodation, materials, and other incidentals incurred during CI coaching sessions in schools or districts shall be charged against school/division MOOE, SEF, and other locally available funds, subject to the usual COA auditing rules and guidelines.
